

## Setting up Web Zones

For example "Current Events" has rules defined to allow students to upload videos to you tube. "Government" has rules defined to keep students from going anywhere online during a Moodle test.




4. Establish "Rules" for your Zone ~granting or restricting access.



## Setting up Web Zones



1. Teacher Access:




Log in using your standard username/password

2. Click on "Add Web Zone"




3. Enter the "Name" for your Web Zone. Description is optional. Name your Zone based on why you are creating it.

1. Activate your Web Zone for the time you specify (2hours or less)




2. Student Access:


3. Student searches for your Web Zone by typing in the title.


