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Introduction

The purpose of the U.S. Department of Education's Civil Rights Data Collection (CRDC) is to obtain data related to the nation's public school districts' and elementary and secondary schools' obligation to provide equal educational opportunity. To fulfill this goal, the CRDC collects a variety of information, including student enrollment and educational programs and services data, that are disaggregated by race/ethnicity, sex, limited English proficiency, and disability. The CRDC is a longstanding and important aspect of the Department's Office for Civil Rights overall strategy for administering and enforcing the civil rights statutes for which it is responsible. This information is also used for policymaking by other ED offices, other federal agencies and researchers outside of ED.

The Ohio CRDC Reporting Guide provides the required setup elements for accurate CRDC reporting for Ohio LEAs. Data elements used in Parts 1 and 2 of the CRDC reports are also listed. Data elements not collected in PowerSchool must be manually entered.

District Setup

The following data elements are required for district setup of CRDC reporting. The first two pages of navigation are removed for brevity:

Start Page > School Setup.

1. On the Start Page, click the **District** link. The District Setup page appears.
2. Click on the **District Info** link. The District Information page appears.
3. Scroll down the page and click the link, Civil Rights Data Collection (CRDC).
4. The Civil Rights Data Collection page appears.

CRDC Report – Part I Fall Snapshot Data

The Civil Rights Data Collection (CRDC) is a mandatory data collection, authorized under the statutes and regulations implementing Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, and the Department of Education Organization Act (20 U.S.C. 3413). The regulations implementing these provisions can be found at 34 CFR 100.6(b); 34 CFR 106.71; and 34 CFR 104.61.

Selection Criteria

Selection criteria determine which database records are used in the report. Refer to selection criteria for analysis when the report does not return the correct records.

All records will be included unless:

- The School has been designated as Exclude from CRDC reporting.
- The Student has been designated as Exclude from EMIS reporting.

The following data elements are used to aggregate student information in each derived CRDC table. They are listed here for brevity and can be referenced when a [Table]FieldName item is listed as Aggregate Fields.

Report Input

To generate the CRDC Report – Part 1, do the following:

1. On the Start Page, set **Term** to 13-14 Year
2. On the Start Page, click **Reports**. The Reports page appears.
3. Click the **State** tab. The State Reports page appears.
4. Click **CRDC Report – Part 1**. The CRDC Report – Part 1 page appears.
5. Enter information in all of the required fields.

Note: Select the checkbox next to the filter fields to save the settings as defaults. To select all checkboxes, choose **Select All** from the pop-up menu. To clear all checkboxes, choose **Clear All**.

6. Click **Submit** to generate the report.
