How to install ESET Endpoint Antivirus (version 5)

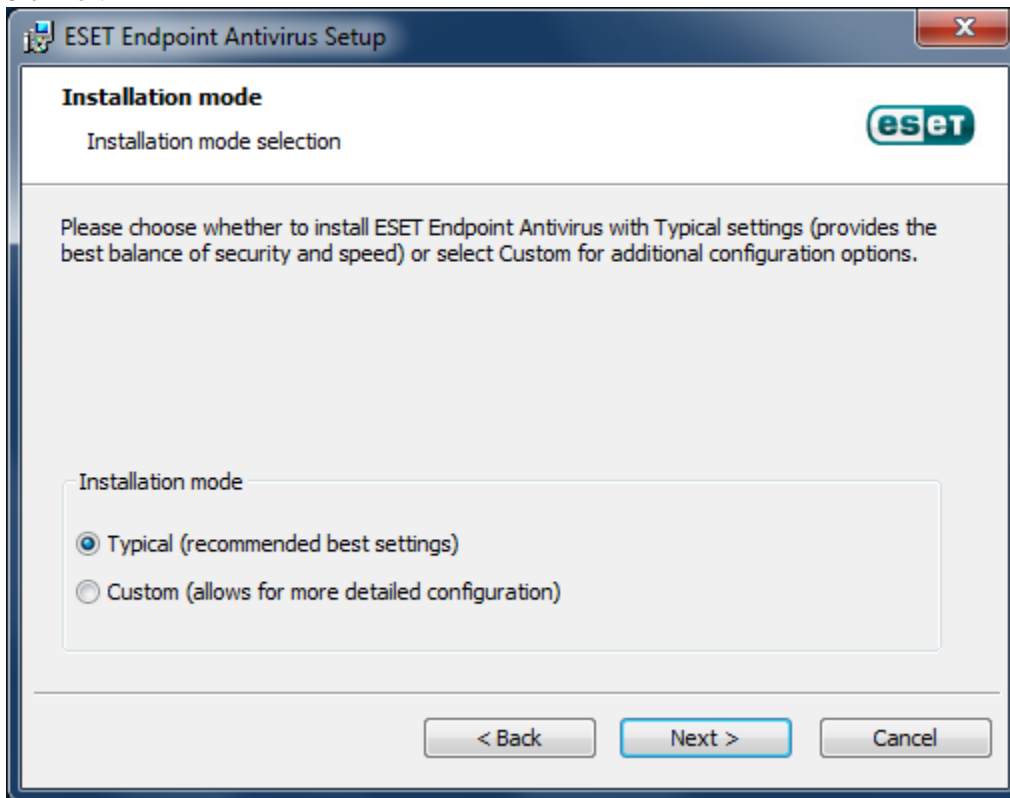
1. Double-click on the ESET Installer File and click 'Next' *(if you do not have the installer, please contact the Hardware Department)*




2. Read and Accept the terms and then click 'Next'



3. Click 'Next'




4. Check the box that says 'Set update parameters later' and click 'Next'



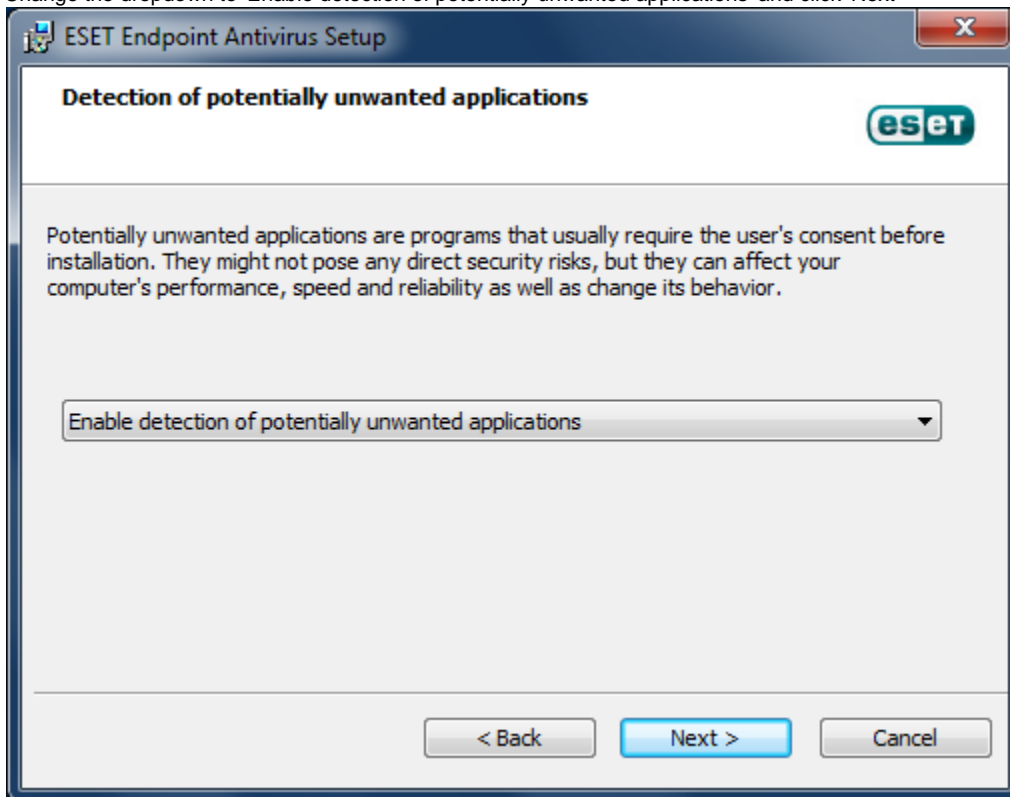

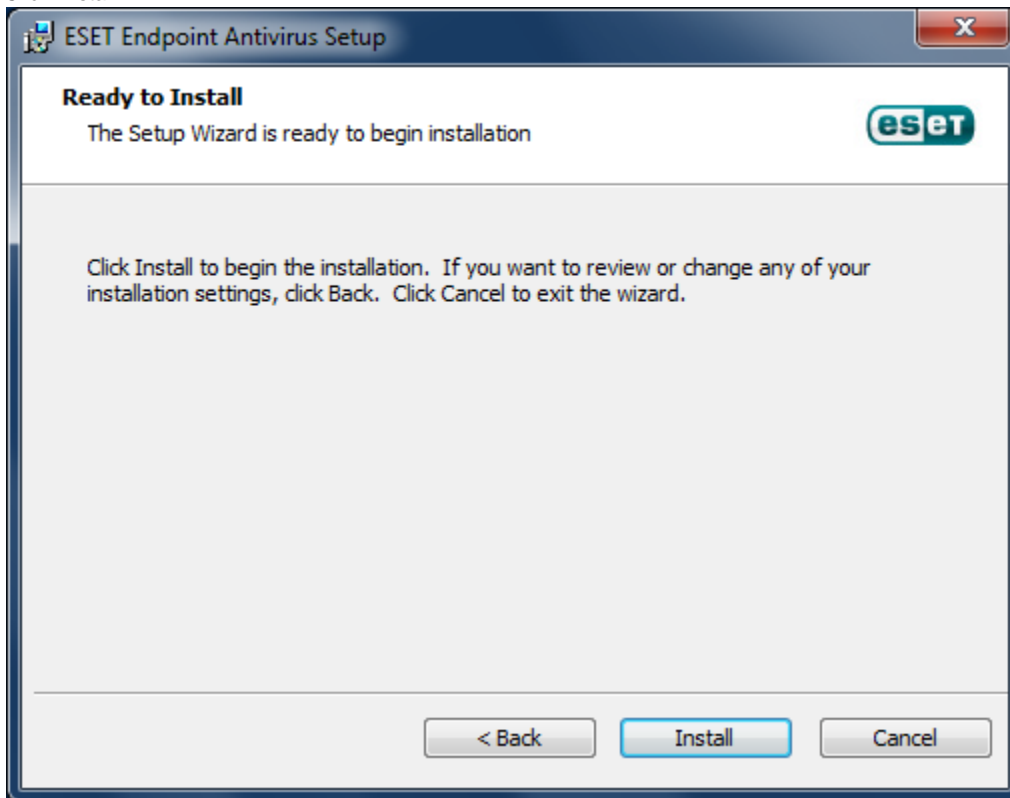

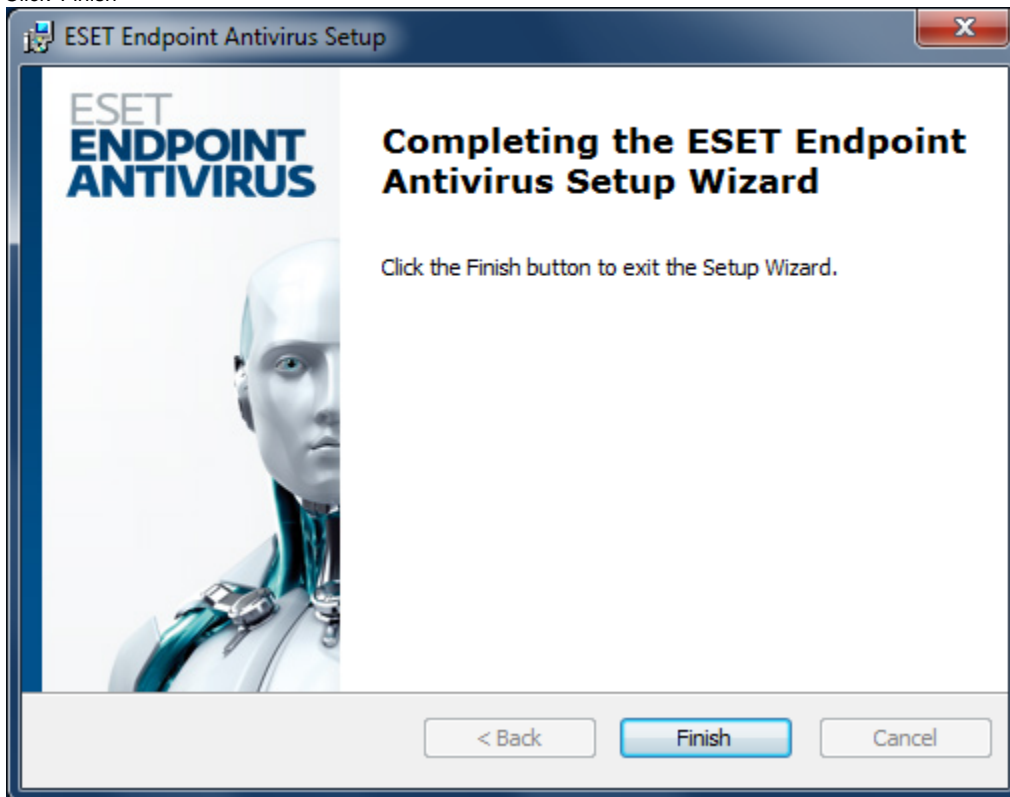
6. Change the dropdown to 'Enable detection of potentially unwanted applications' and click 'Next'
